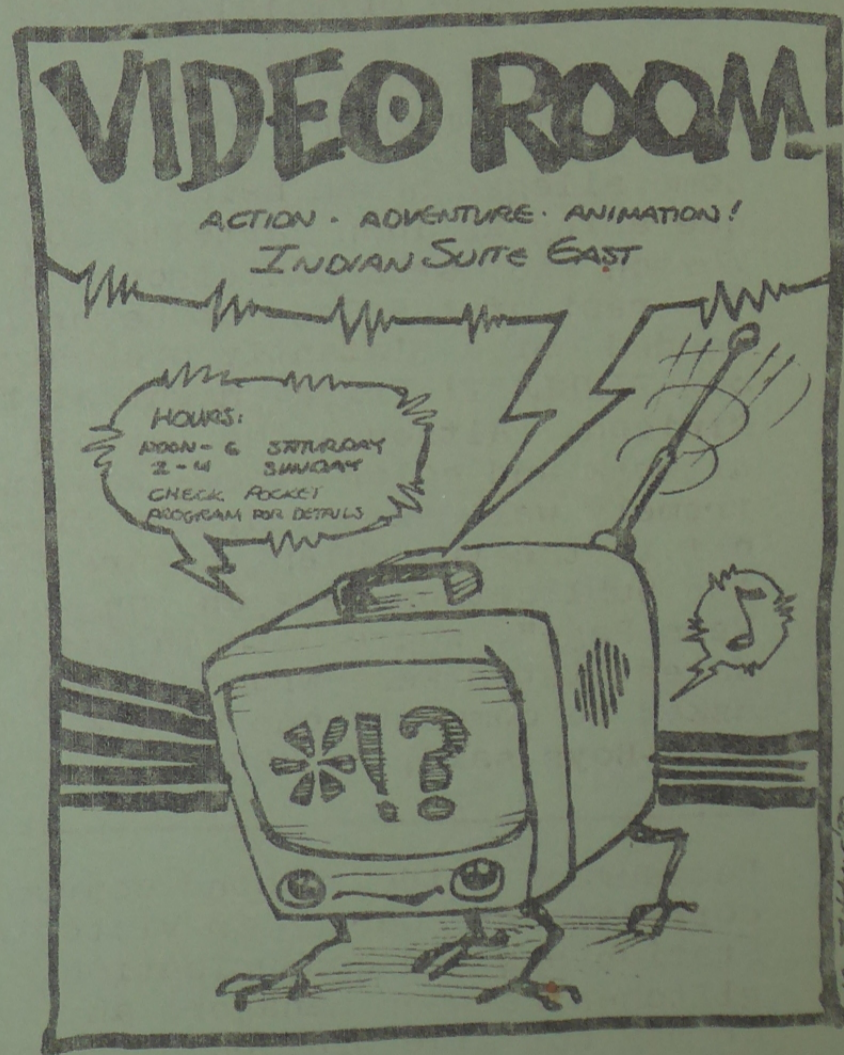
## RUNE-BOYS SCREW UP!!!

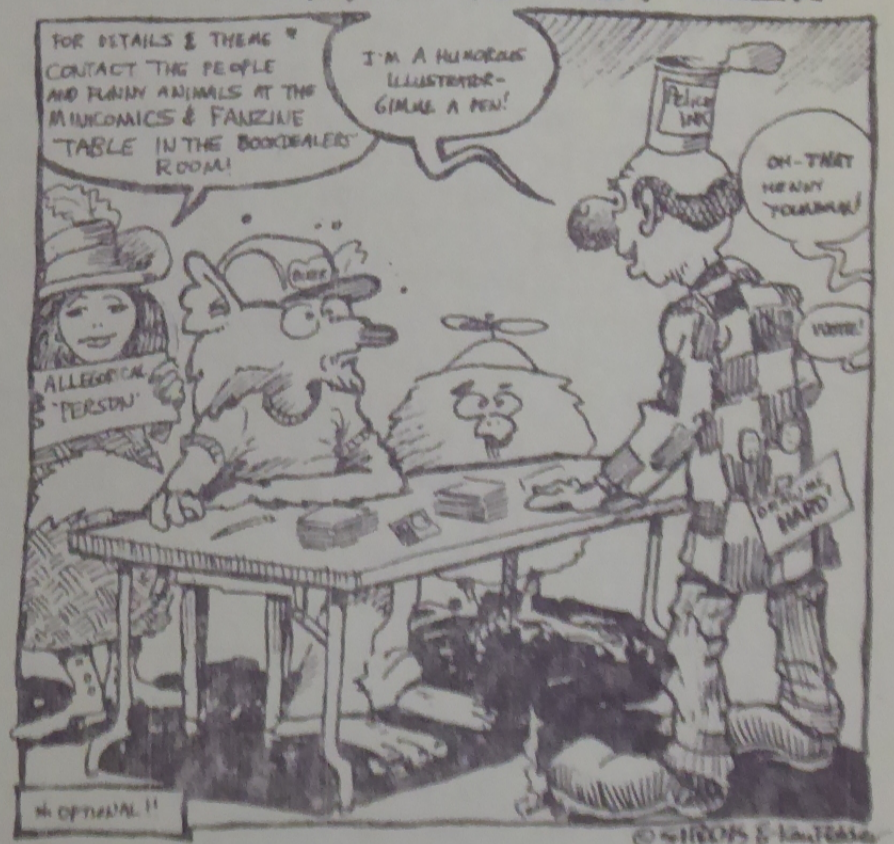
**IMPOSTERS CIRCULATE FRAUDULENT

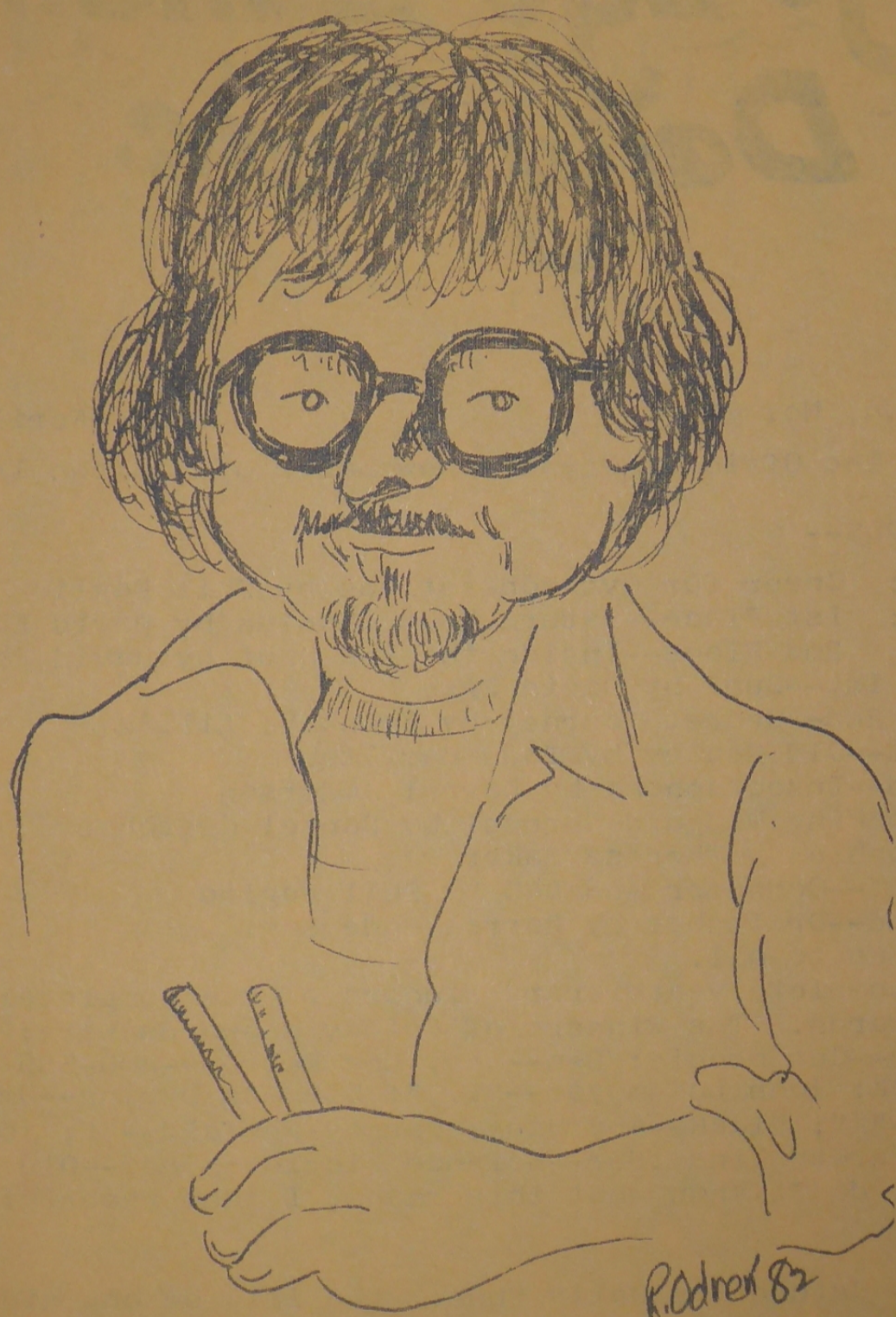
