

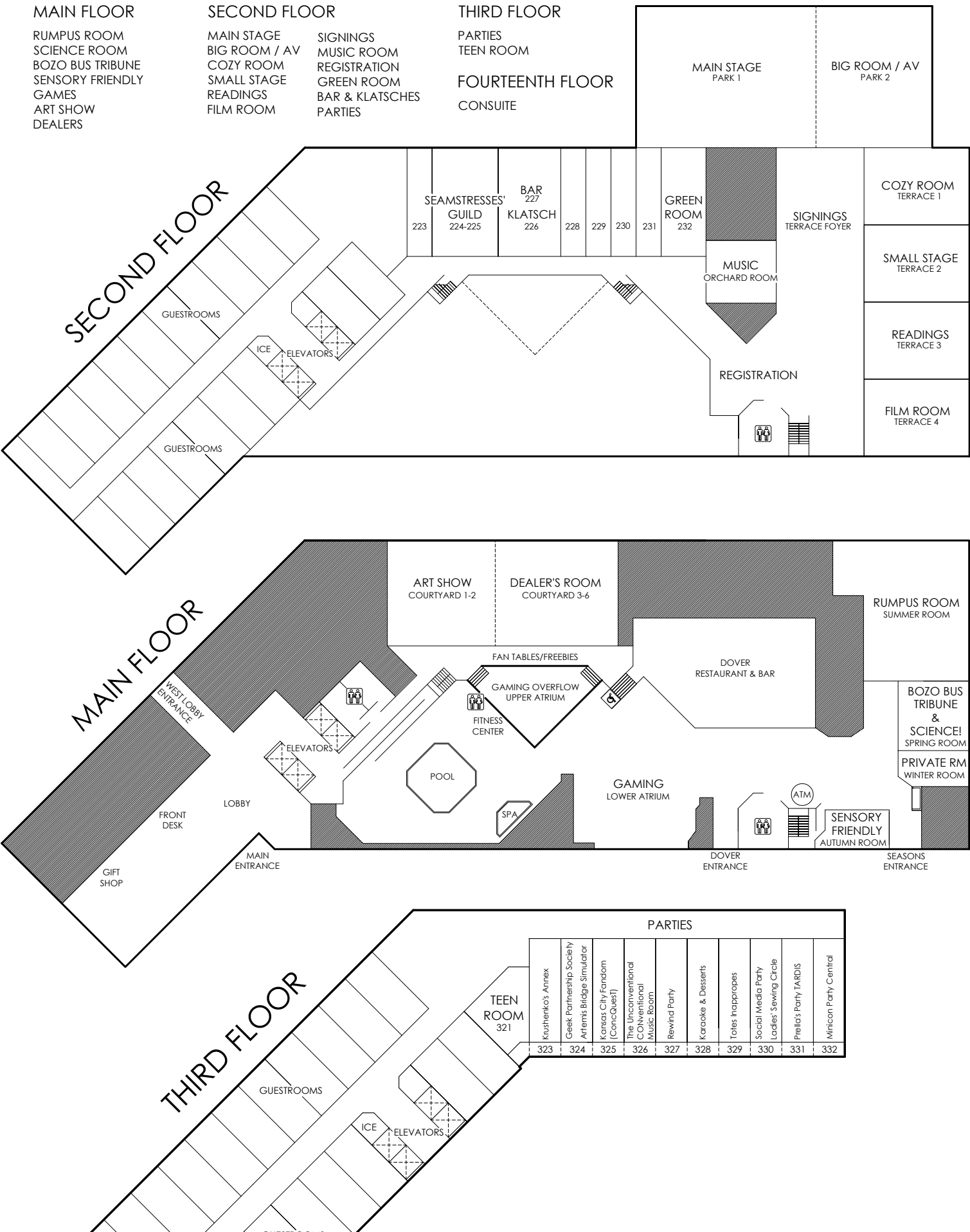

HOTEL MAP



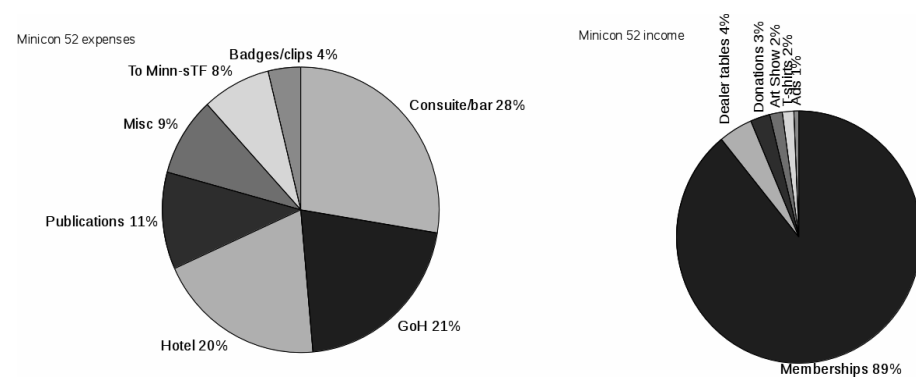

WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO?

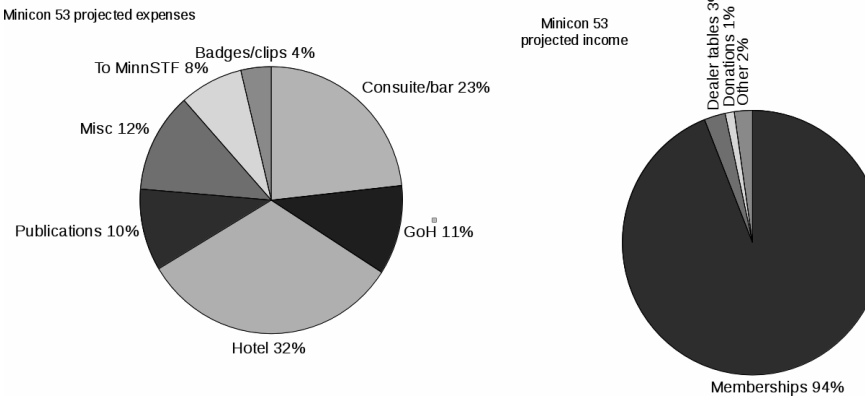
