Saturday's meeting was to have been held at the home of Walt Schwartz, but Walt will be out of town this weekend.

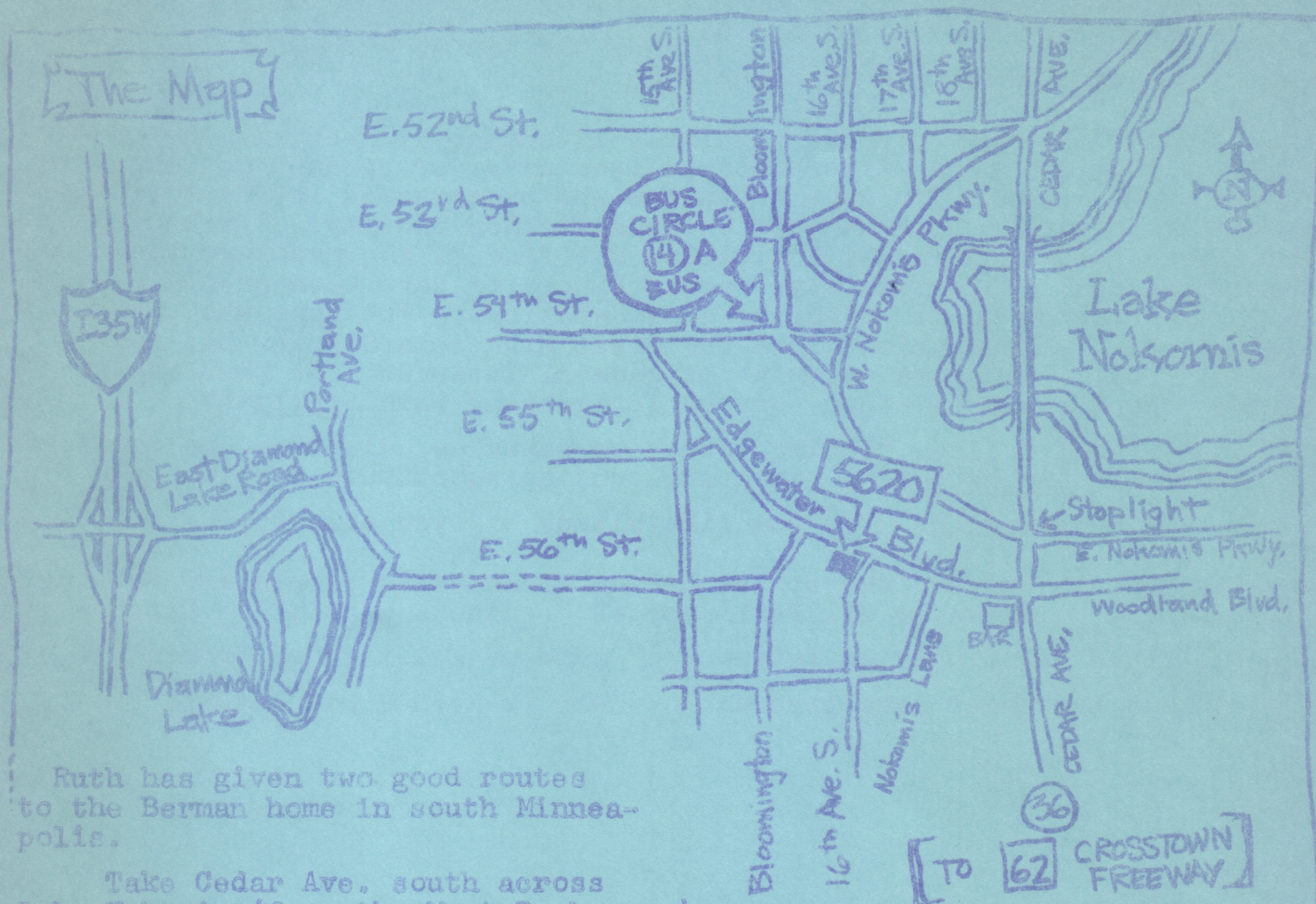

Minicon 3, the Minneapolis regional science fiction convention held April 3-5 at the Dyckman Hotel, had a registration of 180+, with an attending membership of 160+. Programming included Poul Anderson, Gordon Dickson, Clifford Simak, and Manse Brackney and Ken Gray amongst others on the Minneapolis Fantasy Society panel, drinking the case of Grain Belt Beer provided by Joel Lessinger (for the Minn-Stf). Some further information on Minicon 3 will be in coming Runes. A comprehensive final report on Minicon 3 will be published in June.

Our spies say that the attendance at Lunacon, held in New York over the weekend of April 10-12, was over 780 fans--making it the biggest regional science fiction convention ever.
