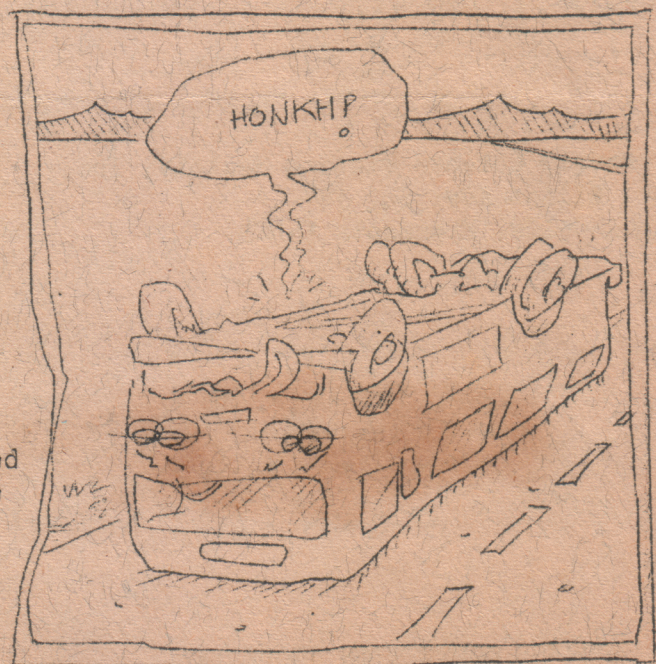

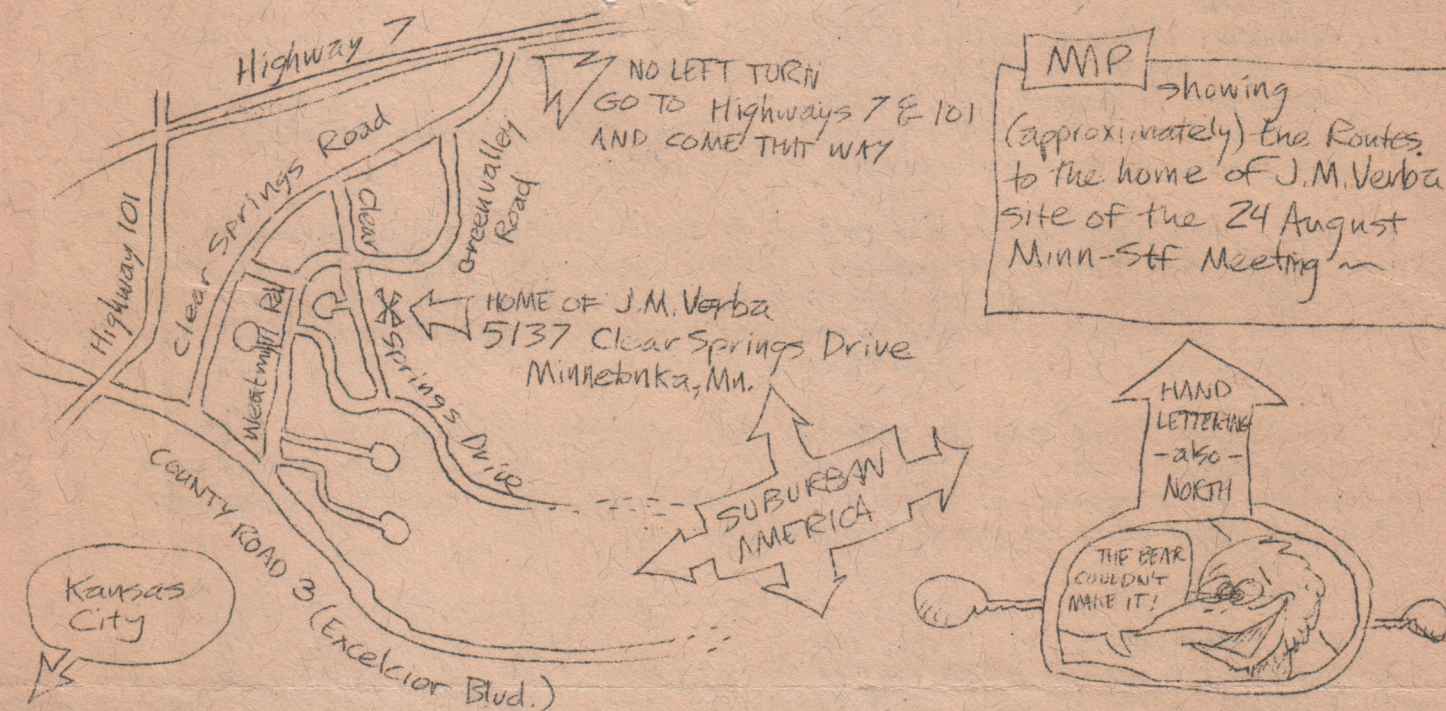
## DIRECTORY UPDATE
